Urunga Lido and Boardwalk



The 1km boardwalk offers stunning views of the ocean, wetlands, valleys, and the Great Dividing Range. Rest areas have interpretive signs, highlighting local history and points of interest.



Hungry Head Beach and Headland

For untouched beaches, surfing, and magical sunsets, this is the spot. The headland offers whale watching during migration, with access to the beach. Feeling energetic? Enjoy a 3.5km walking/cycle path from the Urunga foreshore.

A 450m accessible track and a 150m raised boardwalk offers stunning birdlife, lily pads, and paperbark forest—a photographer's paradise.
